Self Help UK ("we," "us," "our") values your privacy and is committed to protecting your personal data. This Privacy Statement outlines how we collect, use, store, and protect your information in compliance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and other applicable laws.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect the following types of information:

a. Personal Information

- Name, address, email, and phone number.
- Date of birth and gender.
- Identification documents where required for legal compliance.

b. Sensitive Information

 Health data and support needs, only where necessary and with your explicit consent.

c. Usage Data

- Details about your interactions with our website, services, and communications.
- Device and browsing data such as IP address, browser type, and operating system.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use your personal data to:

- Provide and improve our services.
- Communicate with you about our activities, events, and support opportunities.
- Comply with legal obligations.
- Analyse usage patterns to enhance our website and services.

3. Legal Basis for Processing

We process your data under the following legal bases:

• **Consent**: When you provide explicit consent for specific activities.





- **Contractual necessity**: To fulfil our contractual obligations.
- **Legal obligation**: For compliance with legal and regulatory requirements.
- **Legitimate interests**: For purposes such as improving our services and ensuring security.

4. How We Share Your Information

We do not sell your personal data. However, we may share it with:

- Service providers and partners who assist in delivering our services.
- Regulatory bodies or law enforcement agencies where required by law.
- Third parties with your explicit consent.

5. Data Retention

We retain your data only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes outlined in this statement, comply with legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce agreements.

6. Your Rights

Under UK GDPR, you have the right to:

- Access the personal data we hold about you.
- Request correction of inaccurate or incomplete data.
- Request deletion of your data (right to be forgotten).
- Object to or restrict the processing of your data.
- Withdraw consent where processing is based on consent.
- Data portability, allowing you to transfer your data to another organisation.
